## LOCAL POLITICAL.

Dean Swift used to say that censure and abuse are the taxes a man pays for being eminent. Scattered about in the hedges and by-ways of Jackson county, there appear to be scores of men, ready to be enlisted in the next few weeks. The air is fairly thick with the names of candidates and with rumors of cliques and combinations made by these candidates to the clerks office and the sheriffs office, and other desirable places. Men who are in the race for this or that, will assert in the most positive manner that they intend to stand by the convention, and use the next breath in making up a combination or deal for the purpose of capturing delegates from this or that precinct. Such men ought to have the political breath knocked out of them; probably they will have, when the time comes.

If we measure correctly, the temper of a score of those likely to go to the nominating convention, it will take more than a recitation of the creed "I believe in the communion of Jeffersonian saints" to convince them of the honesty and availability of certain would-be eminences. If the assertions of the probable delegates, is of any import whatever, the statute of political limitation does run out in this county, and there will be some sorely disappointed men, when the convention gets through with its work. They will find that even in these local political matters, the rank and file are without rings in their noses; nor are they to be taken with chaff; that there is a standard of what is right and what is wrong, in nominations, independent of the tally of votes. Men who are blind to the truth and deaf to counsel, will discover all this within a very few weeks.

With a majority in the county, that no republican nominee is likely to overtake, the democrats have a splendid opportunity for making a good selection; and to see that the party is wholly free from combination entanglements. It begins to look as tho' the delegates would go out of town for a few of the chief nominees.
